In praise of this non-profit organization, Mike Zoellner comments “The efforts and causes we are supporting are all climbing to higher ground, and doesn’t it make sense for an organization named Red-Peak to support them?”

This celebration marks the end of the “[Climb for Sudan](#)” charity event where two mountain climbers, Joe Rogers and Nick Spivey climbed Colorado’s highest peaks, the 14ers, in dedication to the “Lost Boys of Sudan” and to raise awareness on the devastation that occurred there. Special guests will include; Honorary Chair Jake Norton, and Denver Bronco Alumni, Tyrone Braxton.

“The Lost Boys” of Sudan are more than 20,000 boys who were displaced and/or orphaned during the Second Sudanese Civil War (1983–2005.) Many boys were conscripted to be used as soldiers while girls were raped during village attacks. To avoid capture or death, children had to flee on foot across three countries to find themselves in refugee camps. In total, about 2.5 million were killed and millions were displaced. This twenty-year civil war between North and South Sudan demolished the existing educational system in the South, where only 10% of girls in southern Sudan, ages 7-14 go to school.

Now as an independent capitalist nation, South Sudan recently celebrated their Independence Day on July 9th, 2011. As the newest nation on Earth, a rebuilding of infrastructure and education will be vital to ensure that the country survives. PES’s goal of raising \$100,000 during the *Climb for Sudan* event will fund much needed classrooms, dormitories, bunk beds, teacher salaries and desks.
